







The UnionMigrantNet is a European network of contact points providing services to migrants, established, managed and supported by trade unions.

The aims of the network are to:

- Strengthen trade union activities aimed at enforcing the rights of migrants, regardless of their status
- Increase the visibility and accessibility of trade union services for the integration of migrants at work and in society
- Encourage trade union membership among migrants

The UnionMigrantNet is geared to the full integration of migrants in their host societies and is committed to promoting equality, non-discrimination and respect for migrants' rights as set out in its **Charter of Values**.

## HOW DOES UNIONMIGRANTNET WORK?

- 1 Migrant workers' rights and working conditions
- 2 Access to the labour market and referral to job-matching services
- 3 Trade union rights and membership
- 4 Human trafficking and labour exploitation
- 5 Family reunification and rights of migrants' family members
- 6 Recognition of diplomas, skills and qualifications
- 7 Return processes
- 8 Pre-departure information
- 9 Taxation and social security, portability of rights/benefits/permits
- 10 Social and cultural information on the host country

➤ A web portal [www.unionmigrantnet.eu](http://www.unionmigrantnet.eu) enables contact points to liaise and exchange information.

Through the portal, migrants can also get in touch with contact points active in a specific country. The web portal is currently available in seven languages: Arabic, Chinese, English, French, German, Polish and Spanish.
